NYSDGBA Sale and Raffle Contract

- To nominate an animal the participant must be a member of the NYSDGBA
 - If the participant is not a member please see membership information and form below.
- The committee will accept nominations from the 8 different breeds.
- The top buck(s) from each breed will be selected
- If buck is not selected, Nomination fee will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of the Sale, NYSDGBA will send to each consignor the sale price less the 15% commission and less any accounts payable due NYSDGBA.
- Buck nominations must be born between Oct 2018-April 2019. The bucks are also to be of virgin status; absolutely no natural service is allowed prior to sale date. If you do collect the buck, we request that you process no more than 30 straws. A copy of the ADGA Collection Form, signed and dated by both the processor and owner, and ALL of the straws collected must be made available to the buyer of the animals for no more than the cost of the collection. Should the buyer not desire the collection, the consignor retains the right to keep the semen for his or her own farm use only.
- If your animal is selected for the raffle, you will be compensated the average sale price of other bucks sold or \$500, whichever amount is greater.

- Sale will be held Sunday September 1, 2019 at the New York State Fair, in the Dairy Goat Pavilion @ 2:00 pm.
- The consignor may place a hold price on the consignment below which the goat will not be sold. The hold price cannot be raised once the animal is nominated. The consignor retains ownership if the bid does not reach the specified hold price.
- The consignor agrees to pay the exact consignment fee within seven days of notification of acceptance by the NYSDGGBA Sale Committee as per the following formula: A consignment fee of \$40.00 is required for up to a \$500.00 hold price. A consignment fee of 10% of the hold price is required for a hold price, which exceeds \$500.00. The consignment fee is credited to NYSDGGBA's 15% commission. All NYSDGGBA consignment fees will total 15% of the selling price plus the \$25.00 nomination fee.
- NYSDGGBA Sale Committee reserves the right to remove any animal from the sale for any reason without refund of \$25 Nomination Fee.
- NYSDGGBA will provide top show people to present consignments at the sale, unless consigner provides their own handler.
- All bucks must meet the minimum health requirements for exhibition to the NYS Fair; Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and immunized against Rabies. TB and Brucellosis testing is optional, but recommended for interstate sales.
- Consignments must arrive at the Sale location (at the consignor's expense) no earlier than Sunday September 1, 2019 beginning at 6:00 am and no later than 9:00 am. Each consignor shall provide, at his/her time of arrival, CVI health certificate, ADGA registration certificate, selling displays, brochures and ADGA Collection Form (when applicable), as well as any updated show or performance information since the time of nomination.
- The health certificate must be accompanied with test results and show the animal to have been negative for the CAE testing within 40 days of the sale date.
- All bucks over three (3) months of age must be "off label" vaccinated for rabies. All bucks must be vaccinated at least 14 days prior to arrival on the Fairgrounds and not more than 365 days prior. All bucks must be accompanied by a certification of administration.
- All veterinary certificates must clearly identify the mammal immunized. Certificates must include species, sex, age, breed, owner's name, address and telephone number, vaccine manufacturer, date of vaccination, expiration date of vaccination and the veterinarian's signature, address and license number.
- If the animal is purchased by an out of state bidder further health testing may be required.
 - *Interstate health papers and TB and Brucellosis testing is recommended*

• This contract becomes effective upon the acceptance of the nominee by the NYSDGGBA Sale and Raffle Committee.
