SHOW RULES:

Show is officially sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association for the following breeds (Senior and Junior): Saanen, Lamancha, Oberhasli, Sable, Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine, Recorded Grade, Nubian, Toggenburg

The show will begin promptly at 9 am with the Saanen Specialty in Ring 1 and Nigerian Dwarf Specialty in Ring 2.

Show order for Ring 1 is Saanen, Lamancha, Oberhasli, Sable, Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine, Recorded Grade, Nubian, Toggenburg.

Show order for Ring 2 is Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Lamancha, Oberhasli, Sable, Alpine, Recorded Grade, Nubian, Toggenburg.

Animals will be shown in the order listed above and the show order is not subject to change.

Ring 1 will hold the National Saanen Breeders Association District 2 Breed Specialty.
Ring 2 will hold the American Nigerian Dwarf Dairy Association District 2 Breed Specialty.

Two separately ADGA sanctioned open shows and two separately ADGA sanctioned junior doe shows will be held. These shows are sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association, and the 2019 ADGA rules shall govern.

Proof of registration accepted as per ADGA rules. Please make sure all tattoos are readable. For electronic identification, exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own microchip reader. There will be no pre-show milk. Best of Breed winners must remain until the end of the show for the selection of Best Doe in Show. The Judges' decision will be final.

All animals entered at the sole risk of the owner. The PDGC, its Members and or/the Ulster County Agricultural Society cannot be held responsible for any losses, damages, or accident to any persons, animal or property while on the Fairgrounds.

Animals must be on the fairgrounds by 8 AM, Saturday, July 13th. No other animals are permitted on the fairgrounds unless the show committee gives prior approval. No VEHICLES are allowed in the barns.

Anyone found vandalizing or destroying buildings; property, etc. will be asked to leave the Fairgrounds. Any exhibitors failing to comply with these rules will be removed from the show.

PDGC will have a dumpster on the grounds for shavings and straw only. Please do not dispose of any other materials including trash into the dumpster.

HEALTH CHECK:

7:00 am to 8:00 am

A stringent health inspection will be conducted BEFORE unloading. ANY animal with pinkeye, sore mouth, abscesses, etc. will not be allowed to unload and will be asked to leave with entry fees forfeited.

Please include the following fees with your entries:

Pre-Entry Fees: \$12.00 per animal (includes both rings).

Entries must be postmarked by Wednesday, July 10th. Postmarked after July 10th will be considered Day of Show Entries. Please be considerate and mail your entries early.

Online entries are accepted until Friday, July 12th to be considered pre-entries. If you are planning on sending in entries close to the deadlines, please let Danielle Carolei know of your approximate numbers so we can make sure breeds are official.

Day of Show Entries: \$20.00 per animal (includes both rings)

Substitutions will be allowed within a breed and show. (e.g. an Alpine doe in milk may be substituted for an Alpine doe in milk)

PENS:

Pre-reserved pens are available on a first come first serve basis. Pre-reserved pens must be reserved by Wednesday, July 11th.

There will be no post-show pen cleanup necessary but please be respectful of the fairgrounds.

Dumpster on premise is for shavings and straw only.

Showing out of your trailer is permitted. Shavings are available for \$6 a bag if pre-ordered and \$8 day of the show.

T-SHIRTS:

2019 Champagne Classic T-Shirts are available for \$15 a shirt and can be pre-ordered before the show.

ARRIVAL:

Animals and exhibitors may arrive either Friday evening or Saturday morning. They must be on the fairgrounds by 8 am Saturday, July 13th. For exhibitors staying overnight Friday, RV hookups are available for \$20.

We will have a food booth serving breakfast and lunch.
