



Don Hitchman of Canton, NY passed away on Thursday October 26th, at his home with his family by his side following a long illness. He is survived by his wife Shirley, son Paul and daughter Laurie and grandchildren and great grandchildren.

During their early years they had cows but eventually dispersed their herd. Then Don and Shirley raised show quality Nubian goats under the herd name County Meadows and enjoyed many years of showing their animals. Their goats won many ribbons at local county and state fairs. They were members of the St. Lawrence Dairy Goat Club for years!

They made and sold Feta Cheese which won many awards through the years at the NY State Fair, including best in show over all cheeses!! Soon, their cheese products became extremely sought after,

often selling out at the local farmer's market, Co-ops, and the NYS Fair. Their cheese products were also served at fine restaurants in Lake Placid. In 2004 the couple were awarded Feta Cheese Grand Champion and Supreme Champion against all parties at the NYS Fair.






